Statements of Permission

As the child's parent or legal guardian, you agree...

TRAVEL & TRANSPORT

- That your son/daughter may travel to the UK and study at Chaucer College.
- That your son/daughter may be transported to and from their accommodation by minibus if they are accommodated with a local family ('homestay').
- That your son/daughter may be transported on daytrips and outings by private coach organised and hired by Chaucer College.

ACCOMMODATION

- That your son/daughter may stay in on-site and/or homestay accommodation arranged by Chaucer College.
- That your son/daughter must follow the 'school and house rules' when staying in our on-site accommodation or with a local family.
- That your son/daughter may reside in homestay accommodation that has CCTV installed for the purposes of crime prevention and detection.

CURFEW

- That your son/daughter must be in their College accommodation and their own bedroom by 22:00 GMT.
- That your son/daughter must be in their homestay accommodation and their own bedroom by the time agreed by their homestay host.

TRIPS & ACTIVITIES

- That your son/daughter may take part in any trips organised by Chaucer College.
- That your son/daughter may take part in any social activities organised by Chaucer College.

UNSUPERVISED TIME

- That if your son/daughter is 12 years old or older, he or she may have free time (in groups) for shopping on trips arranged by Chaucer College.

All students aged 11 or under will be supervised during their 'free time' on trips either by a Group Leader or a member of Chaucer College's staff

- That if your son/daughter is 12 years old or older, he or she may have unsupervised free time (in groups) in Canterbury at times designated by Chaucer College.

All students aged 11 or under will be supervised during their 'free time' on trips either by a Group Leader or a member of Chaucer College's staff.

ATTENDANCE & ABSENCE

- That your son/daughter will attend all scheduled classes and activities and will be in their accommodation at the stated times.

If you wish your child to be absent from the course at any time, please contact Chaucer College directly so that suitable arrangements can be made. Where accompanied by a supervising adult, please ensure that you also discuss these arrangements with the Group Leader/agency beforehand.
